The proposed developments are corroborated with the development of the storage system which has a complementary role in supporting the security, stability, optimization and flexibility of the National Natural Gas Transmission System. TRANSGAZ is a member of ENTSOG (European Network of Transmission System Operators for Gas), an entity where the company works together with all the EU gas transmission system operators in order to establish a common regulatory framework and a common strategy and vision for the development of the European gas transmission system to establish an integrated energy market.
