We hereby acknowledge your letter no. 99-00-101-1 dated 12 February 2026 regarding the stage of the environmental impact assessment procedure for the project „Construction of hall building, drainable concrete pool, concrete platforms, fencing, lighting system, execution of drilling and internal network for water supply and sewerage, location of wastewater pretreatment station, location of medical waste incinerator with ancillary facilities”, beneficiary FRIENDLY WASTE ROMANIA SRL.

As you recall from our letter no. DGEICPSC/26232/25.07.2025, the developer has brought legal proceedings in court against the competent environmental protection authority and, in December 2024, the competent court of law has rejected the request on merits submitted by the developer as being unfounded.

At the moment the competent environmental protection authority answered our inquiry, the ruling of the court had been displayed on the Romanian courts portal but had not been communicated to the parties involved in the trial.

According to the legal framework in Romania, the environmental impact assessment procedure is suspended until the case is finally disposed of.
